Resolution

Concerning Stonehenge, Avebury and Associated Sites World Heritage Site

The 4th International Civil Society Forum on World Heritage at Risk supports the recommendations and Draft Decision in the Report to the 41st Session of the World Heritage Committee on Stonehenge, Avebury and Associated Sites World Heritage Site, and suggests that Draft Decision item 7 might be strengthened and clarified to indicate that any A303 road improvements should not impact on the World Heritage Site, its OUV and its setting, as follows:

7. "Encourages the State Party to address the findings and implement the recommendations of both Advisory missions and to invite further World Heritage Centre/ICOMOS Advisory missions to the property, to be financed by the State Party, in order to continue to facilitate progress towards an optimal solution for the widening of the A303 to ensure no adverse impact on the property, its OUV and its setting of the property;"
